DATA SUBJECTS AND PERSONAL DATA UNDERGOING PROCESSING

- Online enrollment via the registration form: Name, surname, affiliations, e-mail address of the data subject.
- Participant in the tutorial via the video-conferencing platform: username, time of entry and exit from the meeting, recipients of any messages sent in chat, mouse movements, clicks, key presses or actions (such as activating/deactivating audio or video).

PURPOSE AND LAWFULNESS OF PROCESSING

RESTART will process the data subjects' personal data for:

- (a) the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party as per art. 6 Para.1 letter b) of GDPR (registration and participation in the tutorial).
- (b) the pursuit of the legitimate interest of RESTART, consisting in including name, surname and contact details of the data subject in its contact database, for sending by e-mail communications related to similar institutional initiatives of RESTART (events, workshops, seminars, training activities). The processing takes place pursuant to art. 6.1 lit. f) GDPR.

CONSEQUENCES OF FAILURE TO PROVIDE PERSONAL DATA

The provision of data for the pursuit of purpose (a) is mandatory, as failure to provide them would not allow registration and participation in the tutorial.

The provision of data for purpose (b) is not mandatory and, during the enrollment, it is possible to object to the processing by selecting the appropriate box at the bottom of the registration form.

CATEGORIES OF RECIPIENTS OF THE PERSONAL DATA

Personal data shall be communicated to the following categories of recipients:

- Partner in charge of managing RESTART web site, email communications.
- Partner in charge of:
 - o organising the RESTART tutorial in terms of contents & planning
 - o providing and managing the video-conference platform for delivering the tutorials.

Where applicable, RESTART stipulated specific Data Process Agreement with the previous mentioned recipients as per art. 28 GDPR; the list of data processors is available upon request.

TRANSFERS OF PERSONAL DATA TO THIRD COUNTRIES

The participant's data can be transferred to countries outside the EU, in particular to the USA, where the provider of the video- conference platform Is established. As appropriate safeguards, the transfer is based on adequacy decisions by the European Commission, or, alternatively, on the Standard Contractual Clause adopted by the European Commission.

DATA RETENTION PERIOD

With reference to the purpose indicated in point (a), data subject's personal data will be stored for a maximum period of 5 years from the end of the tutorial; with reference to the purposes indicated in point (b), the data will be stored by RESTART until the purposes of the processing have been pursued or until – if earlier – the request to unsubscribe from the distribution list takes place.

DATA SUBJECT RIGHTS

The data subjects have the right to request and receive, at any time, information on their personal data being processed by RESTART and to request their rectification.

Where applicable, they also have the right to request the erasure or the restriction of processing of their personal data, to object to their processing at any time and to receive their personal data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format; moreover, they have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority as per art. 77 GDPR.
